“I will not use plastic bags, and I’ll recycle the ones I get”



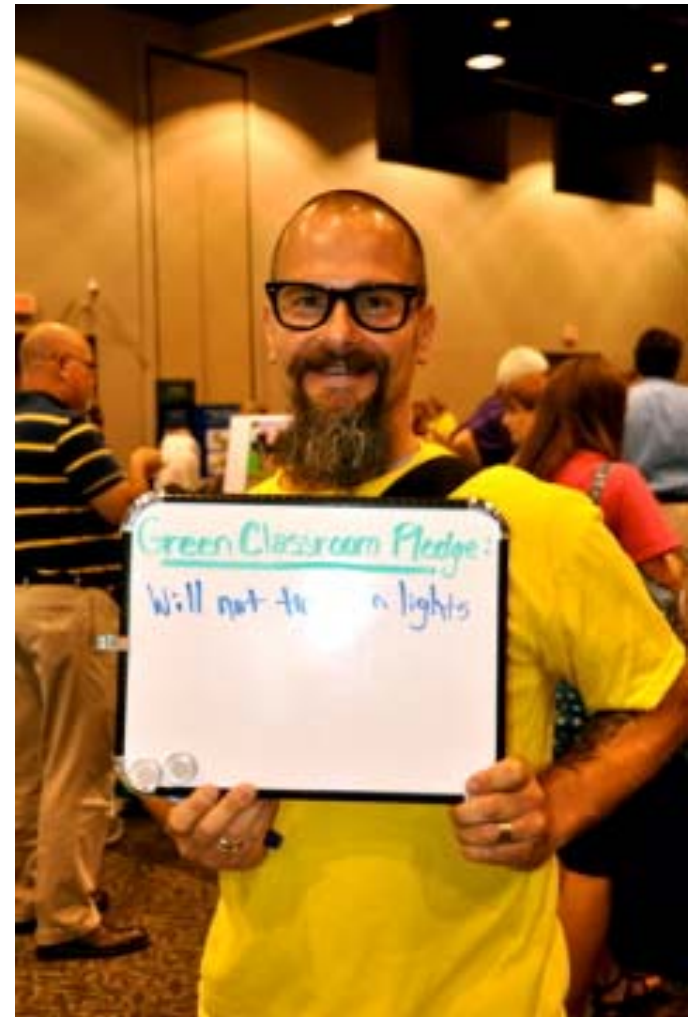
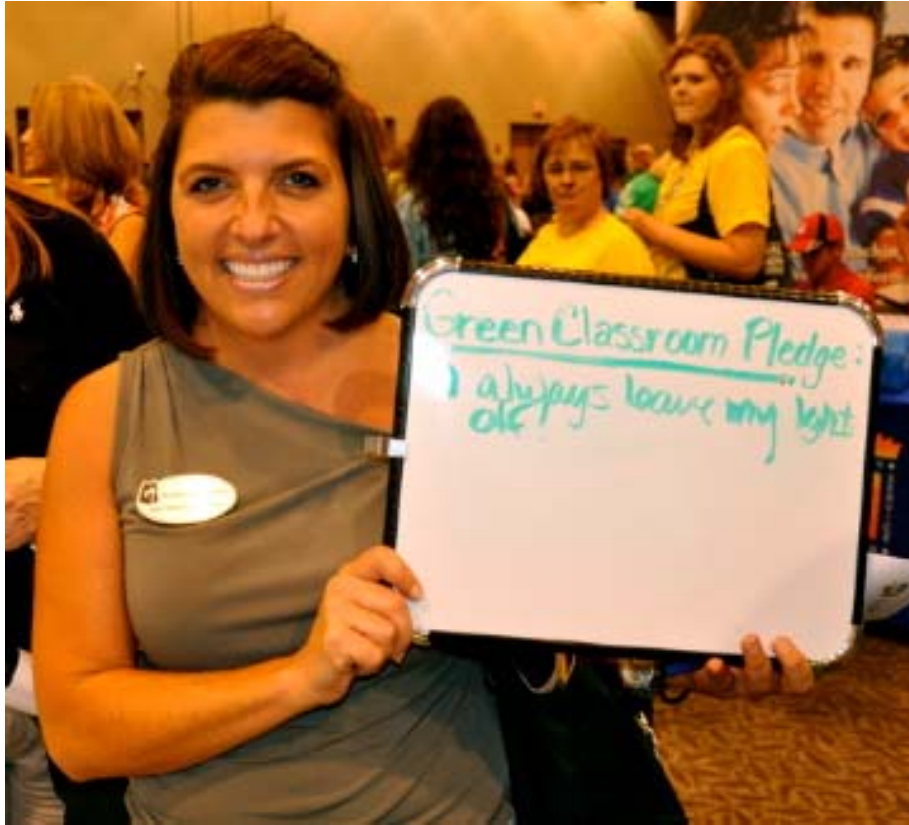
“Model recycling behavior!”
